Subject: Invitation of quotations for exchange of surplus plasma

You are invited to submit your most competitive quotation as per following details:-

1. Bid Price:

- The contract shall be as per MoU/TOR. Correction, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialing, dating and rewriting.
- All duties taxes and other levies payable by the contractor under the contract shall be included in the total price.
- The rates quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- The prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

2. Each bidder shall submit only one quotation.

3. Validity of Quotations: The quotations shall remain valid for 90 days, after deadline date specified for submission

4. Evaluation of quotations: The Society will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which

- Are properly signed and
- Conform to the terms and conditions and specifications.

5. Award of Contract:

- The Society will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the highest evaluated quotation price.
- The society prior to expiration of quotation validity period will notify to the bidder, whose quotation is accepted of the award of contract.
- Notwithstanding the above, the Society reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to award of contract.

6. In case of firm/company found for any misconduct or making direct/indirect influence, firm will be black listed for three years.

7. The firm/company should clearly mention its TIN/CST number.

8. Quotation must be on the **format attached**.

9. An affidavit attested by Notary Public stating that the firm has not been convicted/black listed or its items have not been recalled in last three years should be attached.

10. Incomplete or conditional offer incorporating price maintained and force majeure etc. will not be entertained.

11. The sealed bids should be sent to the office of PSACS, 4th floor, prayaas building, Sector 38-B, Chandigarh on/or before due date/time.

12. Bids received after the time and date specified, will not be entertained in any circumstances
13. You are requested to provide your offer latest by **11.00 A.M.** on **06/01/2017**.
14. Unsealed quotations shall be rejected straightway.
15. No request/reason, of any kind, will be entertained for any delay in reaching/submitted bids late after due date/time.
16. Bids should be sent along with copy of valid license or registration certificate of firm/company for such work.
17. Time Period of work: As per supply order/MoU/TOR **signed by firm/company with** Deptt./Blood Bank of State of Punjab.
18. Uniform exchange rate as per NACO is **Rs1,600/-** per liter of plasma.
19. **Place of work:** Different Blood Banks in the state of Punjab.

Blood Bank with BCSU to provide Surplus Plasma to indigenous fractionators by strictly adhering to the following conditions.

1. The fractionators must undertake to fulfill needs of Indian market first and none of products recovered from the Indian plasma should be exported before fulfilling domestic demand.
2. Uniform exchange value of Rs _____ per liter of plasma.
3. All blood banks must ensure taking of the informed consent of the blood donor for allowing the use of his blood for fractionation and derivation of essential plasma derived medicine there from.
4. The modalities for use of exchange value would be in the form of plasma products, consumables, equipment as per the requirement of blood bank. Any other modality approved by NBTC.
5. Blood Component Separation Unit would directly enter in to an agreement with the fractionators as per mutually agreed terms and conditions before sending plasma for fractionation.
6. Feedback would be provided by fractionators to blood bank in order to provide evidence of the quality of the plasma being fractionated, so as to enable corrective and preventive action.
7. Punjab State Blood Transfusion Council /Blood Bank would review the fractionators periodically so as to prevent any misuse of this strategy.

The blood bank shall ask for an affidavit from the concerned XYZ Company regarding terms & conditions listed above.
